

FAQ on TAA SEPADU Disbursement Application 2027:

1. What is the SEPADU Application Form?

- A common application form for 5 Organisations (TAA, PERTAPIS, MKAC, FIM, UIMA).
- One form to apply for financial or social assistance from the stated organisations. Approval to receive assistance will be subject to each organisations' eligibility criteria.

2. Who can apply?

- Applicant must be 29 and above
- Applicant must not exceed Per Capita Income (PCI) of \$650 and / or gross household monthly income of \$1900.
- Only 1 applicant per family staying in the same household can apply

3. When is the application period?

- Application period is from 5th October 2026 to 30th November 2026

4. Where/How to submit?

- TAA Trust Fund no longer issues physical application forms to applicants.
- Applicants must apply online through sepadu.sg where they are required to complete and upload all their documents there.

6. "I have applied for the funds last year; must I apply again this year?"

- Yes, our application is on a yearly basis. Therefore, applicants need to re-apply yearly.

7. What if the applicant does not know how to submit/complete the form online?

- You may assist them or
- You may ask them to visit TAA office for assistance. Our office is located at Blk 2 Joo Chiat Rd, #04-1121, Joo Chiat Complex, Singapore 420002.

8. What are the supporting documents required to submit together with the application form?

- You may refer to Annex A for the list of required documents.

ANNEX A:

The list of the supporting documents required are:

1. Applicant's NRIC (Front & Back).
2. Certificate of Marriage, Divorce, Divorce Proceedings or Death.
3. NRIC of family member(s) (above 15 years old) staying in the same household.
4. Birth Certificate(s) of children (under 15 years old) staying in the same household.
5. Student Pass / School Ez-Link Card(s) for students or NS Card for those serving National Service (NS) staying in the same household.
6. Latest 3 months Payslips or Employment Contract or Declaration of Employment; from applicant and family members staying in the same household.
7. Past 15 months CPF Transaction History – for applicant and family members (above 21 years old) staying in the same household.
8. Applicant's hospitalisation documents / Doctor's Memo (if applicable).
9. Letter / Card from Prison / DRC of family members (if applicable).
10. Financial Assistance letter(s) from MUIS / SSO Comcare (CDC) (if applicable).
11. Applicant's bank book/s (*if you have more than one account*) stating account number (front page) and pages of latest 3 months transactions, or bank statement(s) showing account's latest balance.
12. Any other relevant documents.
